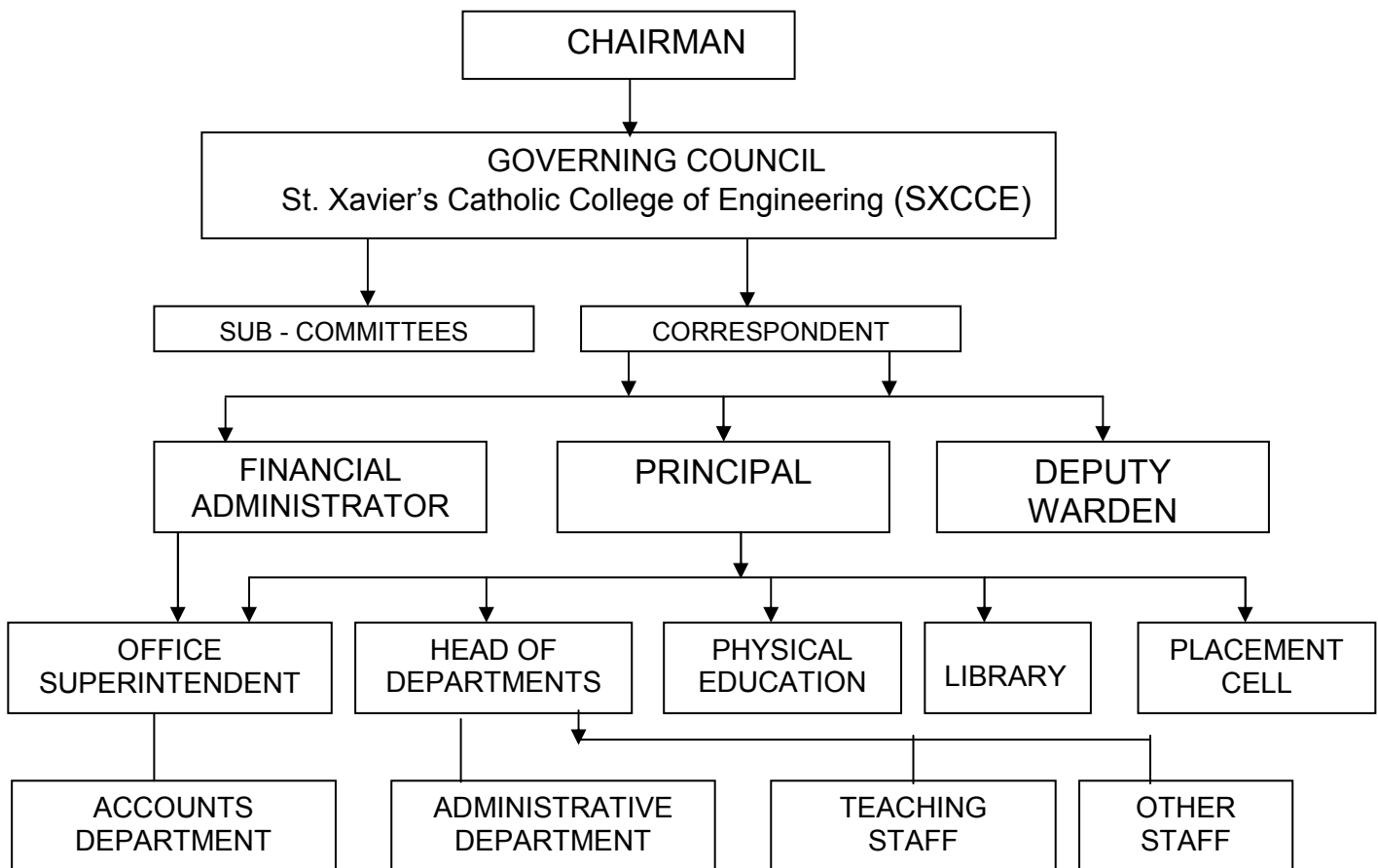
❖ **Frequency of the Board Meetings and Academic Advisory Body**

- **Placement Facilities**

Placement Facilities

The college has a Placement Cell headed by a full time Placement Officer who has a Master's Degree in Management. He is assisted by one staff member from each department. This cell caters to the placement and training needs of the students.

Placement assistance is provided to the students by way of arranging Campus Interviews and training to improve the personality, communication skills, analytical ability etc.

The Placement Cell is also engaged in the following activities:

- Visits various corporate companies regularly to invite them for campus recruitment. Arranges career guidance / Technical Seminars and personal counseling.
- It develops soft skills such as leadership, communication skills, interpersonal skills, team work etc to fit with the requirement of the industry
- Arranges human resources training by inviting management consultants / industry experts from outside
- Organizes Entrepreneur Development Programme to help students who are interested to start their own industry.
- Conducts Aptitude Tests, group discussions and Mock Interviews periodically
- Arranges Industrial Visits.
- Assists to undergo in-plant training to the students during their summer and winter vacations
